Temporary assistance is provided to Reliv consumers who fall on physical or financial hardships. Requests are made by distributors and temporary assistance is offered for 3 months.

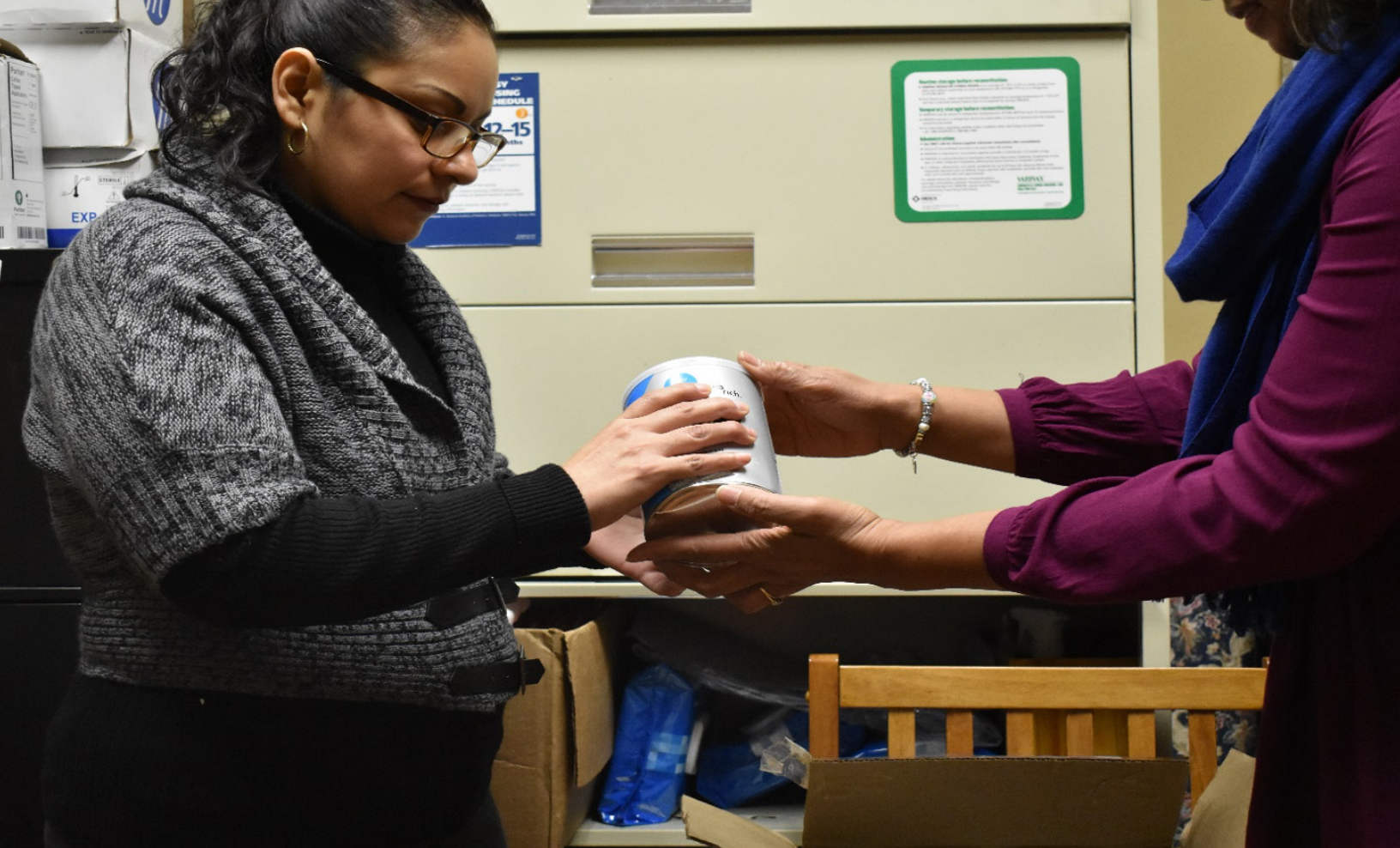
Distributors play a huge role in our US programs. They help identify people within their business or community who could use a helping hand through a rough time.

Haiti suffered in 2021...

Any year in Haiti is a challenge, but 2021 was particularly difficult. Covid-19 was widespread, test and vaccines were unavailable throughout the country until very late in the year. People were quarantined in a country where social distancing is difficult at best.

In July, Haiti's President was assassinated, leaving no functional government in place. The rise of gangs in Port au Prince led them to take control and create their own "rule of law".

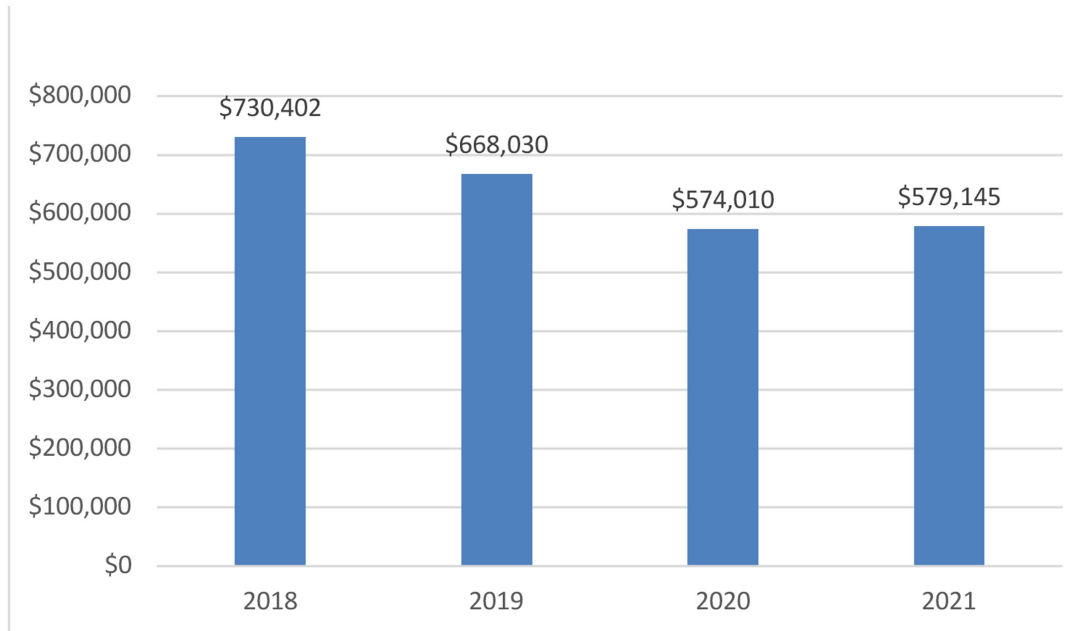
Then, in September, there was yet another devastating earthquake, this time in the southwestern part of the country. The supply lines were crippled and there were countrywide shortages of all commodities and necessities. Prices of food and gasoline skyrocketed. Gas cost as much as \$25 US a gallon. This all resulted in greater levels of hunger and malnutrition throughout Haiti.

Upon learning this news, the board of the RKF initiated a fundraiser in October hoping to send supplemental NOW™ for Kids to meet the increase in requests for aid. Board member Denis St. John secured a matching gift of \$10,000. Within 2 months, a total of over \$28,000 became available to send extra product to Haiti.

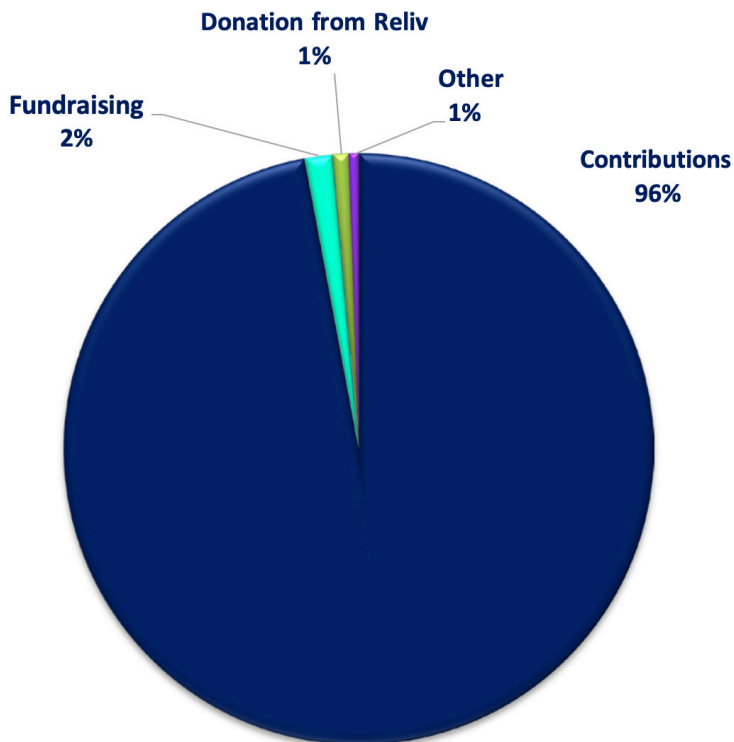

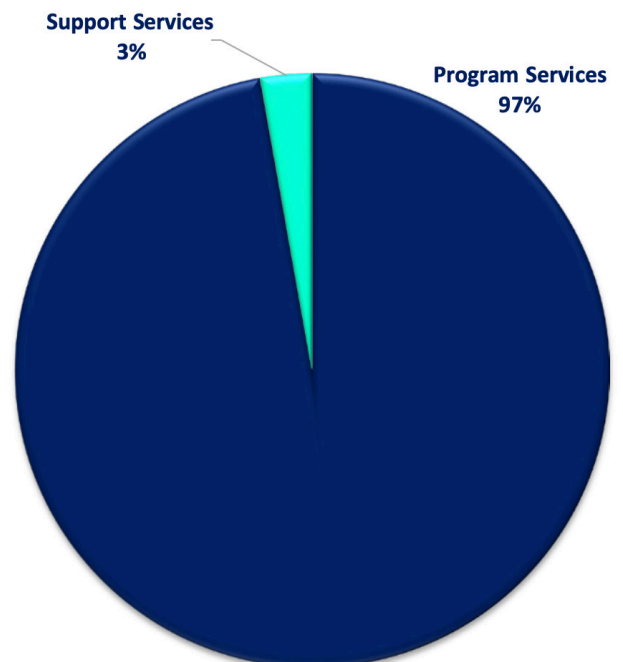
2021 Financials
