In Cambodia, Lydia works closely with the **Field Director - Mdm. Lork Kheng** who is a member of parliament and makes sure our products get into the country at no charge to the Foundation. Mdm. Lork's programs reside in communities in and around the city of Phnom Penh.

In Sri Lanka, Lydia works with the **Field Director - Anne Gunasekera** who raises the funds for clearing the annual shipment. Anne's Programs consist mainly of children on tea plantations in remote areas of Sri Lanka.

The group visited with so many great people including the smiling faces on the receiving end of the shakes. A truly memorable trip was had by all.

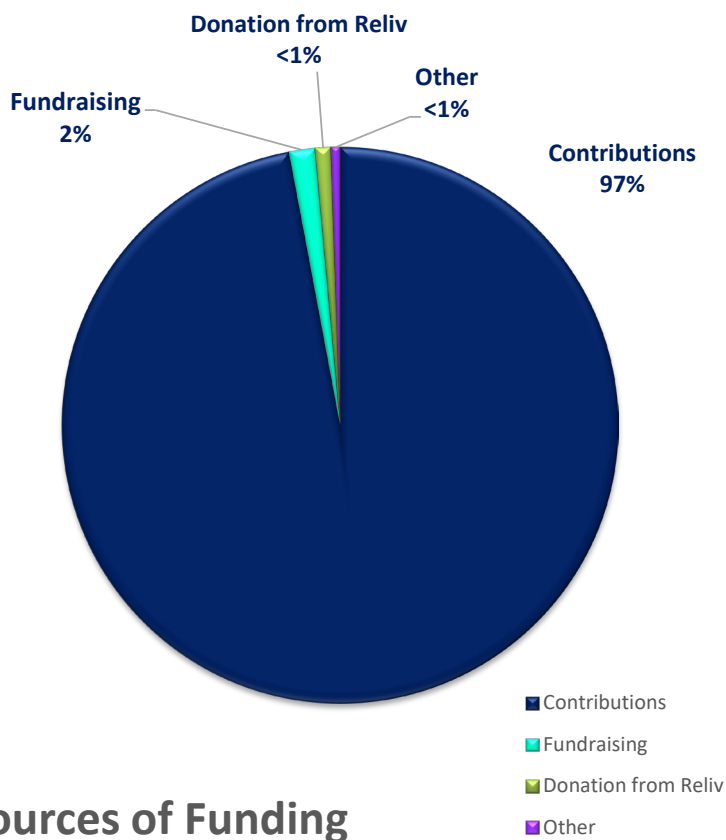
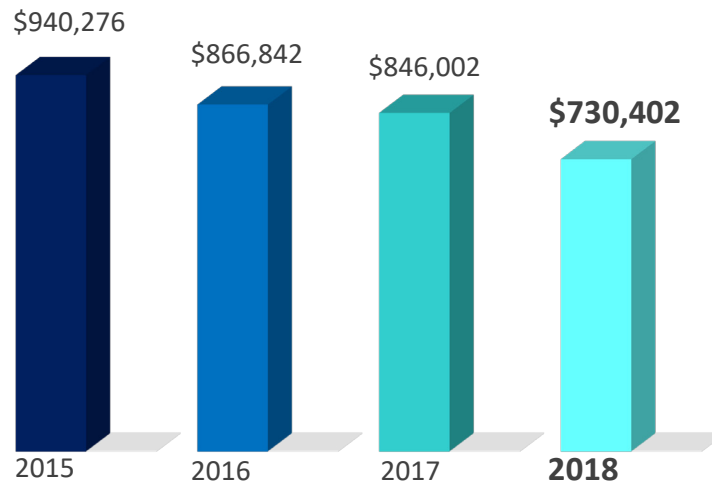

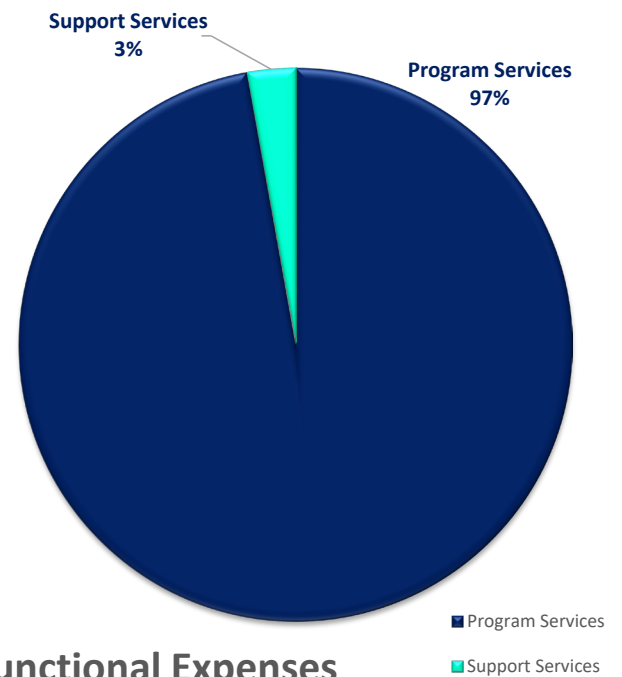
