Gerlande's Story

Guerlande is a beautiful 11 yr. old Haitian girl. In 2016, she was diagnosed with Idiopathic Multicentric Osteolysis of the Carpotarsels. It is a rare, hereditary disease, characterized by loss of bone tissue that specifically targets wrists and feet. The greater threat is renal failure. Fortunately, Guerlande has an aunt who was able to help. Jaimie Weber was adopted as an infant into a wonderful family living in Haiti that is from Canada. Jaimie returned to Haiti upon graduation from college, and ultimately reunited with her sister (Guerlande's mother) and nieces. The Weber family discovered Reliv in 2006, and Jaimie had amazing results, overcoming health issues stemming from her birth in Haiti. The Weber's knew Guerlande and her sisters could benefit from Reliv Now® for Kids. They were malnourished and severely underweight. Jaimie contacted the Reliv Kalogris Foundation for assistance. The girls have gained weight, had less sickness and fevers, have healthier eyes and hair, and much more energy. In 2017, Jaimie and Guerlande came to St Louis to visit a specialist at Shriner's Hospital. The RKF was fortunate enough to host them at Reliv's corporate offices. It was wonderful to have two of our own "Reliv kids" right here in St Louis. Thank you for spending time with us, Jaimie and Guerlande!







Your Dollars at Work

St. John the Baptist School is located in Petite–Anse, a slum outside Cap Haitian, Haiti. Many of the younger residents in the neighborhood are called "restaveks" — children given over to friends, or family members who often do not properly care for them as they should. Restaveks are seldom treated as family members, but rather household servants. The school provides education to 315 children, mostly restaveks, the poorest of the poor.
